COURSE DESCRIPTION

Course: Bible

Grade: Kindergarten

Philosophy Statement: The one true and living God has clearly and accurately communicated truth to man in the Bible. In the Scriptures, God the Creator has revealed to man, the creature, all necessary information concerning God, man, and the history and nature of their relationship, and the one God-ordained way of salvation – by grace through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, in every Bible class we will strive to enable our students to understand and appreciate the glorious nature and works of God more accurately and the true nature of man and his need for divine grace, to the end that each might embrace the authentic saving gospel of Jesus Christ.

Course Objective: The students will develop an initial understanding of the Bible as God's Word and Jesus Christ as God's Son Who came to earth to die for our sins. They will also develop an initial understanding of God as Creator through a study of Genesis, and will be able to recall key facts in the lives of Jesus Christ and King David.

Course Content:

Unit 1: Genesis: Creation to Tower of Babel.

Unit 2: Salvation: Origin of sin; Christ's death and resurrection; the gospel.

Unit 3: Life of Christ.

Unit 4: Life of David.

Areas to be evaluated:

- Oral evaluations.
- Bible story pictures.
- Memory work tests.
