Spelling – There is a spelling test on Friday April 24th. This week’s lesson and test consists of list twenty words I call spelling goblins. These are words that are commonly difficult to spell.

These are the words: veterinarian, victim, vigilante, vinyl, vinegar, vinaigrette, vignette, vitiate, vicious, visualization, volunteer, vulnerable, weave, Wednesday, weapon, weasel, wherever, wholly, weird, wildebeest, whisper

- **As always, there is extra credit available for those students who choose to look up the weekly spelling words in a dictionary, write out the definition, and use them in a sentence and turn it in as homework assignment.**

Bible – The memory verse for April follows the theme of “In pursuit of Holiness” in Hebrews 12:7-11 which addresses the issues of Pursuing Holiness through God’s Discipline. Your student must have this ready to recite on Thursday, April 30, 2009.

Monday, April 20th is a Teacher In-Service. Please remember that this is a minimum day for students. Please make arrangements to pick them up at noon. Anyone not picked up will be sold to pirates.

Shurley Grammar – There is a grammar test on Friday, April 24th.

1. Students will be required to identify the Parts of Speech in the following Pattern 4 sentences. This is new learning that incorporates a Linking Verb, and a Predicate Noun.

- The crocodile is an ugly animal.
- That tall, dignified woman is my grandmother.
- She is the best runner in the class.
- Carla is a member of our math club at school.
- The ostrich is a big bird.

2. New learning this week also includes understanding the use of Regular and Irregular Verbs. Students should know the information found in References 37 & 38 on page 115, and review from previous lessons Reference 28 on page 110.

Math – We are starting Chapter 9, Multiplying and Dividing Decimals. A thorough knowledge of multiplication and division facts is essential. All facts from 1 x 1 through 12 x 12 should be committed to memory for success in this unit. Many students remain weak in this area. I suggest purchasing an inexpensive set of multiplication flash cards and keeping them in the car for quick reviews on the way to school and home, at the baseball field, or any opportunity that presents itself. We are practicing our math facts daily as well, but additional practice at home would be greatly appreciated.
